The event will be bilingual, with simultaneous interpretation between Portuguese and English. In some cases, there will be lectures in Spanish, which will be translated into English only.

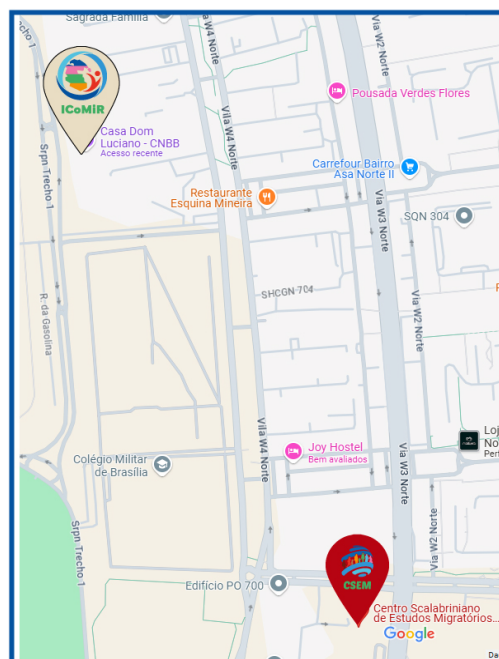

Visa

Check your passport expiration date (minimum validity of 6 months).

Each participant should check with the authorities of their own country whether or not they need a visa to enter Brazil, based on their nationality and country of residence.

If you need an invitation letter, please contact the Conference coordination by email at conferenciacsem@gmail.com as soon as possible, to avoid missing deadlines due to potentially lengthy visa appli-



Accommodation

Accommodation conditions. Rooms can be reserved as single or double occupancy. The daily rate, including meals is R\$ 211.00 (Two hundred and eleven reais). Reservations should be made directly with the Event Organization. Spaces are limited, so we recommend contacting us as soon as possible.



Meals

For specific dietary requirements, please inform us on the registration form so that arrangements can be made in a timely manner, in case of special needs.

Lunch during the event is included in the registration fee.



Sanitary Aspects

The conference organization does not provide healthcare services or medication.

Please check the health insurance and/or vaccination requirements set by the Brazilian agency ANVISA, depending on your place of origin.



Climate

The city of Brasília is located in the Central Plateau, in the Midwest of Brazil, where the average temperature in May ranges from 15 to 27 degrees Celsius. The weather is typically dry, with nights being cooler than the days.



Electricity Power

In Brasília, the electricity supply is 220 V, please check if your electrical devices are bivolt. The Brazilian plug standard is shown in the figure below. Therefore, travelers from abroad may need an adapter, which will not be provided by the event organization.



Currency

The official currency is the Brazilian Real. The nearest currency exchange is located approximately 2 km from the event venue, located at Brasília Shopping.



Transfer from Brasilia Airport to Casa Dom Luciano

The options to reach the house are:

Uber or 99 Pop: costs around R\$40 to R\$50, depending on the time of day.
